## Result (Revised-III)

The final result for the posts of 'A' Class Naib Tehsildar (Apprentices) Gazetted Class-II (Group-B) in Revenue and Disaster Management Department, Haryana against Advt. No. 01 of 2015 published on 23.07.2018 followed by corrigendum dated 01.05.2018 was announced on 16.08.2019. Said result was revised on 08.06.2022 in compliance of directions passed by Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 27507 of 2019. The final result dated 16.08.2019 was further revised on 25.07.2024 in compliance of directions passed by Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 15962 of 2020 and Roll No. 242934 was declared selected in General category.

Roll No. 181898 had filed CWP No. 1652 of 2020 titled as Bijender Vs. HPSC and others in the Hon'ble High Court and said CWP has been allowed by the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 19.09.2024 with the following directions:-

*"As an upshot of the afore discussion, this Court is impelled to direct the respondents to take into account the postgraduate degree of the petitioner to re-determine his marks and consequent thereupon, in case he falls within merit, grant him appointment with notional benefits from the date the last candidate was appointed. Needful be done within two months."*

Said order was challenged by the Commission by filing LPA No. 2932/2024. However, the LPA filed by the Commission was dismissed vide order dated 25.11.2024.

In compliance of orders dated 19.09.2024 passed by Hon'ble High Court in CWP No. 1652 of 2020, the Revised Result-II dated 25.07.2024 is further revised as under:-


**Candidate bearing Roll No. 181898 is declared selected in General category. Further the recommendation of the last selected candidate bearing Roll No. 242934 stands withdrawn.**
